


## Registering and using the Our place forums


**Email:** Your e-mail address. This will not be published anywhere on the site.



Enter some text for your post in the Message field.

If your post relates to a specific location within Australia, it can be tagged and added to the [Our place story map](#). To tag your post, simply click on the globe icon within the form and follow the instructions within the Location finder. Once you have tagged and submitted your post, the Our place moderator will add it to the story map.
